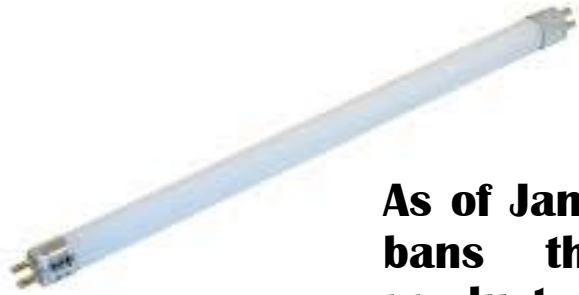


# Don't throw fluorescent bulbs in the garbage...

## ...It's against the LAW!



**As of January 1, 2008, New Hampshire law bans the disposal of mercury-added products. These include:**

- **Fluorescent lamps**
- **Long fluorescent lamps**
- **Circular and u-shaped lamps**
- **Compact Fluorescent lamps (CFL)**

**Please bring these lamps to one of the following locations:**

- **Drop Off Center 13 Recovery Way, (off of West Rd.) Open Saturdays, April to November, - takes CFL's and lamps (tubes)**
- **Benson Lumber, 20 Orchard Dr. Takes CFL's and lamps (tubes)**
- **Walmart, 11 Ashley Dr. Derry - takes CFL's only**
