

HOW DO I REGISTER TO VOTE?

To vote in the New Hampshire, you must be at least 18 years of age, a U.S. citizen, and a resident of the town in which you are voting, and you need a photo ID. Please bring proof of age, identity, domicile, and citizenship to one of the following places:

- Supervisors of the Checklist sessions:

- The polls on Election Day for sameday registration

December 18, 2023; 7:00 p.m. Moose Hill Council Chambers


In November of each year, the Town of Londonderry begins a series of workshops and hearings on the budget for the next fiscal year. The budget hearings are an opportunity for residents to provide input on the Town's proposed budget.

The **current** fiscal year is **FY 2024**. The **next** fiscal year is **FY 2025**. Fiscal years run from **July 1 to June 30**, and are named after the year in which they **end**.

WHY DO I NEED TO REGISTER MY DOG?

Dog registration is required under State of New Hampshire law (RSA 444:1). The revenue raised from dog registration goes toward statewide rabies testing programs to keep all animals - and people! - safe. Plus, registering your dog means that if they are talented escape artists like Lizzie here, Londonderry Police can help get them home.

Assessing Update

Deadline to file an abatement - March 1, 2024

An abatement may be filed with the Town of Londonderry Assessing office following the receipt of your final tax bill. The date of filing is the date the form is either hand delivered to the municipality, postmarked by the post office, or receipted by an overnight delivery service. Deadline to file is March 1st. Pursuant to BTLA Tax 203.02(d) the applicant must sign the application.

Deadline to apply for Exemptions and Tax Credits - April 15, 2024

The following exemptions and credits are available to those qualifying residents: blind exemption, disabled exemption, elderly exemption, solar and wind powered exemption, and Veterans' tax credits.

Londonderry's Town cemeteries are CLOSED to vehicle traffic and for burials for the winter, from December 2023 to April 2024.
