Staffing Update

I am excited to announce that we have filled the Part Time Library Technician position, and he started on September 6^{th} .

Assistant Director's Report:

Programs and Activities -

The Summer Reading Program came to an end on August 31, 2022. A total of 596 patrons participated in the program and read more than 6,300 books!

Circulation and Children's -

In July, the library introduced a new video game collection for the Nintendo Switch. During July and August, the 35 video games circulated a total of 116 times.

Museum passes continue to be popular. As of August 31, 2022, the library has given out a total of 500 passes to patrons since January!

Reference –

In July, there were a total of 1,805 reference questions.

In August, there were a total of 1,961 reference questions.

Technical Services -

There was a total of 419 materials added to the collection in the month of July. There was a total of 686 materials added to the collection in the month of August.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Sub-grant #2 Update –

- I submitted the final report to the NH State Library on August 30.
- 336 patrons registered for a hoopla account during the grant period, and 407 users have registered to date. 100% of the initial deposit has been spent.
- The marketing campaign concluded at the end of July. We exceeded our goal and registered 514 new patrons!

Instead, Erin suggested suspending overdue fines for books permanently.
