Assistant Director's Report:

Circulation -

September was Library Card Sign-Up Month. We participated in the Granite State Library Card Challenge, a friendly competition between New Hampshire libraries. During the month, we signed up or renewed 189 patrons, which is a 4.4% increase!

Reference -

In September, there were a total of 1,521 reference questions.

<u>Technical Services</u> –

There was a total of 651 materials added to the collection in the month of September.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Sub-grant #2 Update -

Our final report was accepted by the New Hampshire State Library on October 3rd. Our grant obligations are now complete.

Old Business:

• Energy Audit

Erin is working on finding a contact person or company for an updated energy audit.

New Business:

• Deep Clean Proposal

Erin presented a quote prepared by the library's current cleaning company, A-1 Phoenix Cleaning Services, for a deep clean of the building totaling \$1,219.00. A discussion ensued. The Board agreed that the deep clean should be scheduled.

Budget FY24

Erin presented a draft of the FY24 budget. A discussion ensued. The Board will revisit the budget at the next meeting.

• Circulation Policy

Erin presented a new Circulation Policy to the Board. The new Circulation Policy replaces the former Borrowing Privileges Policy, Non-Resident Library Cards Policy, Organization Library Card Policy, Fines for Overdue Materials Policy, Library of Things Policy, Interlibrary Loan Policy, and Book Discussion Group Policy. A discussion ensued.

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A **motion** was made by Kim Bears to accept the new policy. The **motion was seconded** by Robert Collins. All in attendance accepted the motion, **motion carried**.

• HVAC upgrades (ENE)

Erin presented quotes for two HVAC upgrades from ENE Systems of New Hampshire totaling \$1,535.00. The upgrades are for installing wet switches on each of the three rooftop units and installing temperature sensors in the north wall soffit. The expectation is that these upgrades would help prevent flooding issues the library has faced in the past. The Board agreed both installations should be scheduled.
