Dear Property Owner,

National Grid and Eversource Energy have submitted a Wetlands Permit Application to the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) as part of their siting approval process through the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee for the Merrimack Valley Reliability Project (MVRP). The MVRP is a joint project between National Grid and Eversource Energy that involves the construction of a new overhead 345 kV electric transmission line (which will be known as the "3124 Line") within an existing electric transmission right-of-way (ROW) between National Grid's Tewksbury Substation in Tewskbury, Massachusetts, and Eversource's Scobie Pond Substation in Londonderry, New Hampshire. The Project also involves the relocation of an existing 115-kV overhead transmission line (which is known as the Y-151 line) within the existing ROW in the Towns of Pelham, Windham, and Hudson, NH.

You are receiving this notice because you have been identified as a property owner with property that has an easement for or abuts the existing ROW. This letter serves as a notice that a Wetlands Permit Application has been filed with the NHDES. The Application requests authorization to impact wetlands in order to construct the 3124 Line and relocate the Y-151 line within the existing ROW. A copy of the NHDES Wetlands Permit Application is on file and available for review at the town hall in each affected town, and at the NHDES Office located at 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH.
