A Resolution Relative to the

ELECTION CAMPAIGN VIDEOS POLICY

First Reading: 01/21/02

WHEREAS

the Londonderry Town Council wishes to establish a policy to provide all political candidates with equal opportunity in the airing of campaign videos;

and,

WHEREAS

the Town's position is that fair and just relations between employees and candidates for political office are fundamental to the conduct of the Town's affairs; and,

WHEREAS

the Londonderry Town Council fully supports the principle of protecting and safeguarding the right and opportunity of all candidates to have equal access to the cable studio and facilities, as well as equal public access channel time,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Londonderry Town Council that the Election Campaign Videos Policy, a copy of which is attached, is hereby adopted.

Chapter XVI - ELECTION CAMPAIGN VIDEOS POLICY

SECTION I PURPOSE

- A. It is the policy of the Town of Londonderry that all political candidates shall receive equal treatment in the access and use of the Cable Studio and its personnel and facilities in the production and airing of campaign videos.
- B. The Londonderry Town Council and all members of management are committed to the spirit and letter of this policy.

SECTION II LIMITS/AUTHORITY

- A. Equal access shall include, but is not limited to: training, utilization of volunteers' time and technical expertise, and the use of Cable Studio facilities and equipment.
- B. Cable volunteers and employees shall be free from coercion for any political purposes. Employees are prohibited from using official authority or position for the purpose of seeking to interfere with or affect the result of an election or a nomination for public office.

SECTION HICREATING A VIDEO

- A. Candidates will be informed as to how they can create their own campaign video in the Studio utilizing volunteers.
- B. Londonderry Access Center (LAC) Staff will not produce videos for candidates.
- C. Appointments for studio use are taken on a first come, first served basis, and should be made as soon as possible, but all candidates shall be allowed to produce videos.
- D. Candidates' videos will be limited to thirty (30) minutes in length, timed from the beginning of the tape, and shall include ten (10) seconds of black or color bars at the beginning, title, show content, and credits and the end.
- E. Warrant article videos will be limited to one video, recommended to be thirty (30) minutes in length.
- F. Credits must include, at a minimum, the name of the producer, and the copyright holder and year.
- G. Tapes must be labeled with a title and an accurate time, timed from the beginning of the tape.
- H. Candidates will be informed that it may be necessary to copy their tape for the logistical purpose of fitting all programs into the Playback Schedule.
- I. Tapes are not previewed by anyone. Producers and candidates take responsibility for the content and accuracy of their videos by signing a Statement of Compliance with LAC Policies.

Chapter XVI - ELECTION CAMPAIGN VIDEOS POLICY (Cont'd)

SECTION IV VIDEO SUBMISSION AND PLAYBACK

- A. Each candidate's one video must be delivered to the LAC no later than 6:00 PM on the fourth Monday three weeks prior to the date of elections, and shall air for two weeks.
- B. Videos will be aired on a rotating schedule and shall advance in sequence one hour daily.

SECTION V COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

Any candidate who feels aggrieved by a denial of any provision of this policy may process an appeal in accordance with the Town Council.

Samoisette stated that he was surprised there was a Budget Committee member at the School Board meeting who said they were going to use Dominion machines, even after all the bad press the machines have received. For voting. Samoisette stated that with all the research, those machines are filled with bugs. Samoisette said the machines are equipped with wifi and Bluetooth. Samoisette also asked if there was more to the Gandia story and why was that done to her. Chairman Farrell stated that the Council is bound and restricted by 91:A by State law. They are not allowed to discuss personal or employee matters. Samoisette stated that as an outsider looking in, it doesn't look right.

Name: Tom Este

Address: 9 Old Nashua Rd, Londonderry

Este stated that he is a lifelong resident. Este stated that he is apart of LRC with Councilor Franz. Este wanted to know why, if they can't use the community room, why can't any room in Town Hall be used. Este stated that he called multiple towns and they let the public use their buildings, town halls, libraries, etc. Chairman Farrell stated that the Town Charter was written in 1996. There are several members who are still alive. Article 4, which is 'Administration of Government', 4.6, "the manager shall have full jurisdiction over the rental and use of all town facilities under the managers control. The manager shall be responsible for all maintenance and repair of all town property under the managers control, within the limits of existing appropriation". Chairman Farrell state that the Council doesn't make the decision on whether or not we use the building for other things. Chairman Farrell stated that we do rent out the Senior Center. The Library has their own rules. The Police Department is under the Chief per State law. Este stated that the Councilor supersedes all of the managers and chiefs, yet they can't give the citizens a room to use. Este stated that people pay taxes and they can't use a room. Este stated that the rules can be change. Chairman Farrell stated that they cannot.

Este brought up the Gandia issue. Este respectfully asked that the Council drops the no-trespassing on the Gandia's. Especially Chris. Este stated that he cannot believe he spent half of his life protecting and serving this community, and how disgusting it is that we put a no-trespassing in this town. Este stated that he doesn't even live in this town. Chairman Farrell stated that he lifted the five-minute limit. Este stated that this is shameful. Este also stated Laura Gandia did her job perfect, and we let her go. And now we are hiring Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission, a lady to work fifteen hours a week, making more than one hundred dollars an hour. Este stated that is over three times what Laura Gandia got paid, so how are we saving money. Este stated that he doesn't understand why the town would let a valuable asset, and we let her go, and now we are hiring SNHPC. Chairman Farrell stated that under 91:A the Council will not answer personnel questions. Chairman Farrell sated that the Town Council has no jurisdiction over lifting the notrespassing order. That is between the Town Manager and the police department.

Este also asked why we put things in the Derry News and not the Londonderry Times. Chairman Farrell stated that is an operational issue.

- on the Budget Committee. Douglas asked if Kipp should have resigned. Douglas also brought up
- the five-minutes public comment rule. Douglas stated that he hopes people come out and vote and
- fix what is wrong in this town.






