Londonderry Housing & Redevelopment Authority Term Adjustment/Reappointment

Explanation of Circumstance:

The Londonderry Housing & Redevelopment Authority, a Town Board established by Londonderry Municipal Code Title V, Chapter II, Section I.D.3, is required by NH RSA 203:5 to have five commissioners appointed to staggered five-year terms. Because of previous resignations, the terms of the current commissioners are out of alignment with the statute. This adjustment will bring the Board back into compliance.

Commissioners & Terms:

Dave Abbott - appoint to a one-year term expiring 12/2024

William Mee - appoint to a two-year term expiring 12/2025

Greg DePasse – appoint to a three-year term expiring 12/2026

Chris Powers – appoint to a four-year term expiring 12/2027

*Board chair Dan Root was already reappointed to a five-year term expiring 12/2028

Once appointed, commissioners will be directed to the Town Clerk to sign updated Oaths of Office.
