Dear Mr. Farrell,

On June 21, 2021, the NH Drinking Water and Groundwater Advisory Commission (Commission) to the Drinking Water and Groundwater Trust Fund (DWGTF) completed their review of the Special Projects Assistance Program funding application submitted by the Town of Londonderry. The Commission authorized a funding award to the Town of Londonderry for the following program:

<u>Project Description</u>	<u>Funding Award Amount</u>
PFAS Residential Remediation Rebate Program	Up to \$500,000 in Grant funds

The next step to move forward with program funding is to submit a final application. The documents are listed on the enclosed checklist and available online at [Link to Final Application Forms](#).

Once the final application has been submitted, the Town will enter into a grant agreement, which must be approved by the Governor and Executive Council. Also, retroactive program related work that has been completed may be eligible for reimbursement once the funding agreement is in place and approved by the Governor and Executive Council.
