### Housekeeping & Misc.

- Paul discussed the Going Green columns and their status. Paul said that the columns that were due for November/December will now be submitted for January and February 2019.
- The book donation bins are up and running and an article was in the paper regarding this matter. Bob indicated that the new company is still developing a schedule to empty the bins and assure the bins have available capacity for donations. The committee will be reviewing the status of the bins and how the new vendor performs.
- Paul, Rick and Duane decided that they will attend the February 25<sup>th</sup> Hudson Sustainability Committee meeting to exchange ideas. Paul will clear that date with the Hudson group.

• KC Signs will be moving the Welcome Sign near the Backyard Brewery sometime this spring.

### Main Topics

- Mike Byerly from the Beautify Londonderry (BL) program filled the committee in on his thoughts for the future of BL. He feels that Londonderry has outgrown trying to control litter through a volunteer effort and it appears that volunteers' interests have waned. He suggested a new idea would be to have residents focus on cleanup up their own neighborhoods, with support from the BL committee. The committee discussed how we might get the word out to the residents that BL needs new leadership. It was decided that a request for residents that might want to take over the program should be put out on the Town website as well as on several of the local Face Book pages. Paul asked Mike if he would help with the transition process before he leaves BL and he said he would.
- Paul and Rick discussed the upcoming compost bin sale. Rick had gathered information from NRRA regarding the purchase and sale of compost bins from them. The committee discussed this matter with Bob since the Town will be purchasing the bins based on the resident's interest. Some of the possible communication outlets discussed for the announcement were the Londonderry Times, the Committee's Facebook page, the Town Website, Other Town organization's Face Book pages, etc. The points we will try to get out will be: 1. What the committee is offering, 2. Benefits of composting, and 3. What it takes to compost. Joy developed a Google interest form and passed it out to the committee for their review. Rick planned to send a draft of the write up to the committee by Friday (1/18), and feedback is due back to Rick by Tuesday (1/22). Rick will then send us the final version by Thursday (1/24) for placement in the outlets mentioned.
- The committee discussed the Leadership Londonderry Program. Paul will be going to this meeting to explain what the committee does and how it operates.
   There are 21 residents signed up to listen to the presentations on February 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Paul made an announcement at the last meeting that he was going to step down from the committee at the end of 2019 and would accept nominations for a new chair at the January meeting. Lynn Wiles offered to serve as chair. Paul said he would help Lynn with the transition process.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:55.
