20	and available. DeFrancesco stated that the committee is looking at the area right next to				
21	town hall. The idea is to put up a two-story building with a wing, much like the original				
22	plans, make it look exactly the same on the outside as well. DeFrancesco stated that there is				
23 24	a time crunch for a few reasons. It has been in the works for a little over a year now. Slater stated that he came in front of the Council a few months ago, having discussions about next				
24 25	door. Slater stated that they will be presenting to the School Board tomorrow night.				
25 26	DeFrancesco stated that the site that's there now is a cost avoidance of a million and a half				
27	dollars. DeFrancesco stated that there will be a guarantee price by the design/building				
28	people that will go to the voters on the ballot. The Councilors expressed concern for the				
29	ownership portion of it. DeFrancesco stated that it is important that this passes. The Council				
30	discussed parking and to make sure there is enough.

32	Ray Breslin, 3 Gary Drive, stated that on the original warrant article, it said to redo the				

33 existing building, and then the building was torn down. Chairman Farrell stated that the

34 warrant article didn't say we had to use the same building. The Building Inspector deemed
