**ORDINANCE 2007-09**

***AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE VI, CHAPTER XIII, AMBULANCE  
FEES AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF***

***WHEREAS*** the Town of Londonderry provides Emergency Medical Services through its Fire Department; and

***WHEREAS*** the Town charges a fee for said services, which are critical to offsetting the cost of providing said services, and

***WHEREAS*** the Town has experienced a significant number of delinquent accounts and should consider additional collection measures;

***NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED*** by the Town Council of the Town of Londonderry that the Title VI, Chapter XIII of the Municipal Code is hereby amended, effective immediately, to authorize the use of credit agency reporting and collection agencies to reduce the number of delinquent ambulance fee invoices.
