

**TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

With no objection, minutes for meeting of January 7, 2019 were approved.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Rt 128 @ Pillsbury Road – Matter has been tabled to July 8, 2019. John Trottier has been communicating with NH DOT.

Mammoth, Page & Grenier Field Roads – Public Works Director Czyzowski advised the committee he is looking at a blinking light for this intersection. Matter tabled to July meeting.

Pasquale's - Route 102 – Senator Carson advised the committee that she is receiving calls from citizens about town wide traffic complaints. A discussion took place regarding the traffic along Rt 102 and the increase of businesses in the area. Although there is nothing the committee can do as Rt 102 is a state road, and the state will not change the speed limit. The town will keep apprised of developments along Rt 102. Matter tabled to July Meeting.

High Range & Alexander Road – Don Turcotte explained to the committee of his continued concerns of speeding traffic on High Range Road. Chief Hart advised he has assigned radar details to the area, now that spring has arrived, the department M/C will be on the road again. Captain Bernard will set up the speed trailer in the area. Matter tabled to July Meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Old Mammoth Road – The committee discussed Old Mammoth Road regarding vehicles using Sanborn, Hall Road to High Range Road & Harvey Roads. This road is being used as a cut through to get to the airport. Wallboard Supply trucks are leaving their headquarters early in the morning and travelling on Old Mammoth Road. Committee discussed hours of operation for trucking.

Town Manager Smith made a motion to “visit the issue on Old Mammoth Road at the next meeting”.

High Range & Cross Road – Dan Raymond along with others in attendance discussing the speeding vehicles on High Range Road. Mr. Raymond advised the committee that the curve at Cross Road is sharp and asked for help. Discussion followed with Public Works Director Czyzowski advising that he will look into a yellow 25mph curve sign. Chief Hart advised that units will be asked to give the area attention. Radar signs were suggested. Tabled to July meeting.

Litchfield Road – Ryan Prud’homme advised the committee that he is experiencing speeding vehicles on Litchfield Road, most especially trucks not abiding by the posted no thru trucking times. Carter Bennett also in attendance advised he too has been unable to get out of his driveway with speeding cars. With young children in the area, this is a concern for the residents. Chief Hart and Captain Bernard advised they would look into radar signs and soon the department M/C will be in use. Matter tabled to July meeting.

Town-wide Traffic Study – Town Manager Smith advised the committee that he is recommending a town wide traffic study as the town has grown and continues to grow with developments.

Burton Drive – Steve Mason from Felton Brush advising the committee that they are experiencing issues with Stonyfield Farm trucks parking on Burton Drive, his trucks cannot see oncoming traffic. Mr. Mason was requesting no parking signs on the Stonyfield Farm (10 Burton Drive) side of the road.

Public Works Director Czyzowski made a motion to have “No Parking Signs on Burton Drive by Stonyfield Farms”
2nd by Chief Hart
All approved

Shasta Drive – Public Works Director Czyzowski advised the committee that he has received a number of calls from residents of Shasta Drive by Nutfield Country Store. Customers are parking, especially trucks on the road making it difficult to turn onto Shasta or out of Shasta onto Rt 128.

Public Works Director Czyzowski made a motion that, No Parking Signs be put up on both sides of Shasta Drive by Nutfield Country Store.
2nd by Chief O’Brien
All approved
